



## Biotechnology for the Life Sciences Pre-application form

This form is intended for students interested in enrolling in the international graduate program “Biotechnology for the Life Sciences” at the Department of Biotechnology, University of Rijeka. This, combined with the other documents listed below, will be used solely for assessing whether students are eligible to apply, based on their previous undergraduate studies. For applicants beginning October 2020 only, applicants must not be of Croatian citizenship. Please also note that applicants must have sufficient time between the awarding of their undergraduate degree and the start of the program in Rijeka, to allow for official recognition of their degree program by the Croatian academic system, and to apply for a visa if necessary.

- 3) List of courses/components in your undergraduate degree, issued by the university awarding it<sup>14</sup>

Please supply all documents in the English language<sup>15</sup> and as PDF files. All students submitting pre-application forms will be informed of the results by email. If you are eligible to apply, then you will be invited to submit a full application.

<sup>14</sup> This can be a detailed transcript of grades, if it includes the names of courses. The grades themselves will not be assessed at this stage of the application process, which is focussed purely on eligibility to apply.

<sup>15</sup> If your degree certificate and/or course list is not available in English, then some other languages may be acceptable at this stage, please contact us for more information. Please note that, if you are successful in your application, we will later need a certified translation (court interpreter) of your degree certificate, if it is not written in either English, Croatian, Bosnian or Serbian (Latin alphabet), before you can officially enrol.
